Scholarship Selection: **One scholarship selection per student**

HBA Scholastic Award: \$1,000

Three \$1000.00 scholarships will be awarded to students who are completing their senior year at one of the eight public Washington County high schools: Boonsboro High School, Clear Spring High School, Hancock Middle/Senior High School, North Hagerstown High School, South Hagerstown High School, Smithsburg High School, Williamsport High School, Washington County Technical High School.

Hagerstown Community College Scholastic Award: \$1,000

A \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded to a student accepted into Hagerstown Community College pursuing a career in the Home Building industry or related field.

ABC, Inc., Barr Construction Institute Scholarship Award: \$2,320 **[Apprenticeship Training Program Information](#)**

All Washington County High School students are eligible to apply. If student is deemed a viable candidate for this scholarship an interview and application submission for the ABC program will be required. Scholarship approval will be based upon acceptance into the Barr Construction Institute Apprenticeship Program. Scholarship covers one full year of training.

Eligibility Requirements:

Student must:

- Maintain a 3.0 GPA or higher.
- Be accepted into a college, university or trade school.
- Be pursuing a career in the Home Building industry or related field including (but not limited to): Architecture, Engineering, Interior Design, Construction Management, Drafting & Design Technology, Landscaping Architecture, or any other field identified within the construction industry.
- Enrolling as a full-time student – 12 Credits or more.

Scholarship Application Process:

Complete and submit the following:

- Completed Scholarship Application
- Official high school transcript of grades
- Letter of acceptance from a college, university or trade school
- A written essay describing academic and career goals, any experience or volunteer work within the field, and why the student feels he or she should be selected for the scholarship award. No less than 500 words and no more than 700 words.
- Applicant may be required to be interviewed by the Scholarship Advisory Committee at their high school or via phone.
- Final selection will be made by the HBA Scholarship Committee.

Important Information:

- Scholarship money will be paid directly to the student's account at the educational institution where they have been accepted.
- Student must be available to attend an award ceremony on May 25, 2017, at 7:00 p.m. at Bulls & Bears Restaurant, Mezzanine, to accept the award.
- Student's photo will be taken and submitted to The Herald-Mail newspaper.
- Application deadline date is April 15th, 2017. Submit applications and documents to HBAWC 19735 Leitersburg Pike, Ste. A, Hagerstown, MD 21742. All mailed applications must be postmarked by April 15th, 2017.
